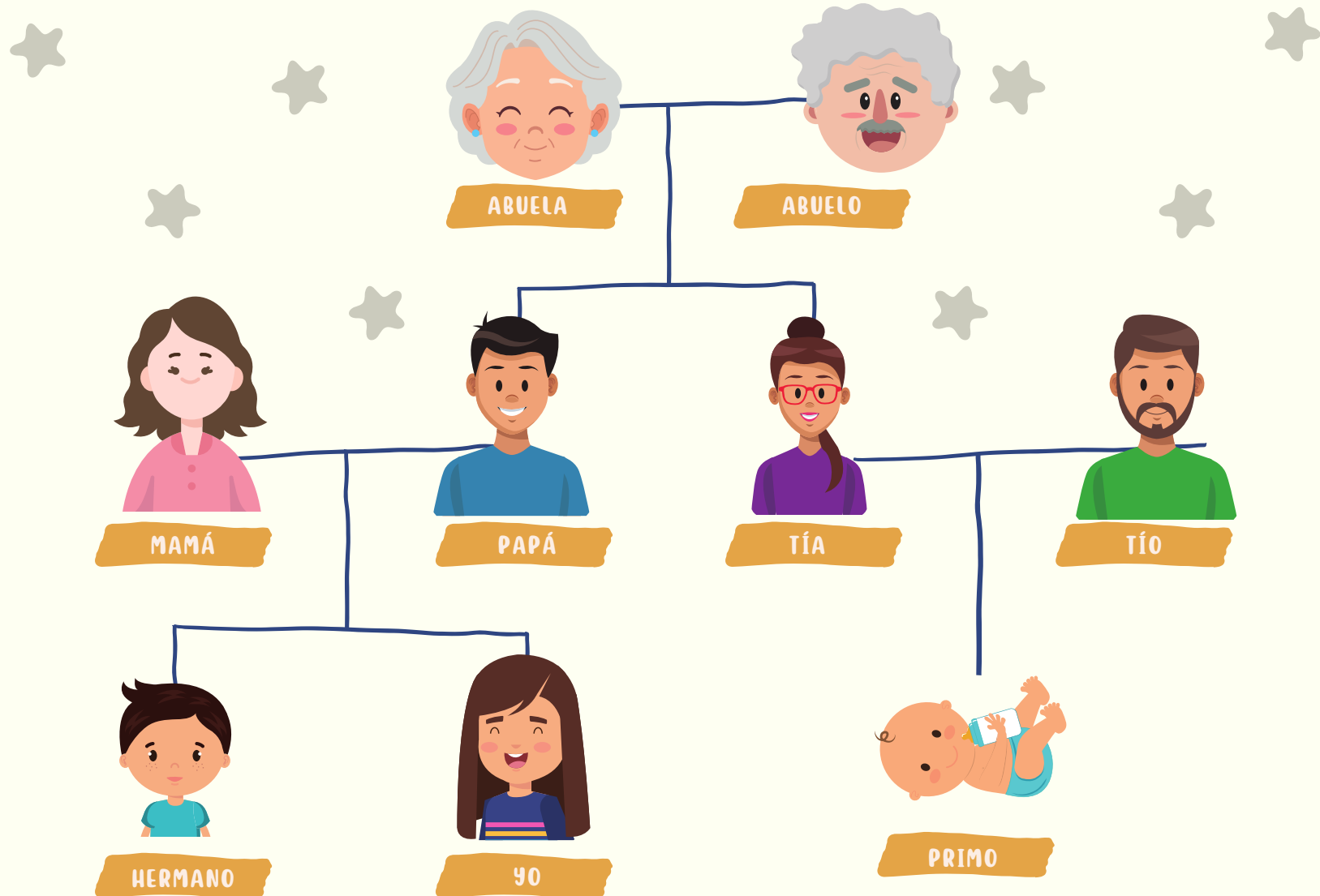

- Suegro: father-in-law
- Suegra: mother-in-law
- Nuera: daughter-in-law
- Yerno: son-in-law
- Cuñado: brother-in-law
- Cuñada: sister-in-law
- Tío político: uncle by marriage
- Tía política: aunt by marriage

Tú	Tu (s)
Él / Ella	Su (s)
Nosotros	Nuestro (s)
Vosotros	Vuestro (s)
Ellos / Ustedes	Su (s)



Mi mamá se llama María.

My mom's name is María.

Nuestros papás son ingenieros.

Our parents are engineers.

¿Cómo es tu familia/[pariente]?	How is your family/[relative]?
¿Quién es el [mayor/menor]?	Who is the [oldest/youngest]?
¿Cómo te llevas con tu familia?	How do you get along with your family?
