#### TO FALL, TO LIKE

#### SYNONYMS: HUNDIRSE, ABATIRSE, TROPEZAR, AGRADAR

-ER	YES	<b>Caer</b> To fall	<b>Cayendo</b> Falling	<b>Caído</b> Fallen

	Indicative	Subjunctive	Imperative
Irregularities	<b>Present:</b> <i>caig</i> (only 'yo'). <b>Preterite:</b> <i>cay</i> for third person singular and plural.	Present Subjunctive: caig for all subject pronouns. Imperfect Subjunctive: cay for all subject pronouns.	Affirmative: caig only for 'usted' and 'ustedes'.  Negative: caig for all subject pronouns.

### **DEFINITIONS & EXAMPLES**

#### CAER

# #1 - Express that something or someone falls or goes down

(To fall / To go down)

**Formula** 

(Reflexive pronoun) + ['caer' conjugated]

¿De dónde **te caíste**? Where **did you fall** from?

¡No caigas en su juego! Don't fall for his game!

Ojalá no se **haya caído** el internet. Hopefully the internet **hasn't gone down**.

**Take Note:** <u>Use reflexive pronouns</u> (*caerse*) anytime you want to express that a person falls from one place to another.

#### #2 - Talk about liking or disliking someone

(To like)

**Formula** 

[Indirect object pronoun] + ['caer' conjugated]

Tu novio nunca me **ha caído** bien. I **have** never **liked** your boyfriend.

¿Crees que le **caeré** bien a tu familia? Do you think your family **will like** me?

No sabía que Tania te **cayera** mal. I didn't know you didn't **like** Tania.

**Take Note:** When used to talk about liking and disliking people, *caer* behaves like 'gustar'. To learn more about these verbs, check my guide on how to conjugate verbs like 'gustar'.
