

INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS IN SPANISH

LIST OF INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS

There are 6 main indirect object pronouns with an alternate 7th:

IOP	English
Me	Me
Те	You (informal you)
Le (se*)	Him / Her / It / You (formal)
Nos	Us
Os	You (plural, Castilian)
Les (se*)	Them / You (plural)

Explanation on Le vs Se:

The <u>pronoun se</u> is <u>only</u> used to replace le or les in sentences with <u>double object pronouns</u>.

In other words, when a sentence contains <u>both</u> third-person direct (lo, la, los, las) and indirect object pronouns, we must use se instead of 'le' or 'les'. This change is made for semantic purposes.

INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS IN SPANISH



Patty <u>le</u> dio una flor a Laura. Patty gave <u>Laura</u> a flower.

Explanation: In this example, Laura is <u>positively</u> affected by the action.

INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS

Replace the person/thing <u>affected</u> by the verb.

Person	ΙΟΡ
Уо	Me
Τú	Те
Él / Ella	Le
Nosotros	Nos
Vosotros	Os
Ellos / Ustedes	Les

EXAMPLES WITH & WITHOUT INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS

WITH INDIRECT OBJECT

Joe enseña <u>a los niños</u> a contar. Joe teaches <u>the kids</u> to count.

Charlie compró esos chocolates <u>para mí</u>. Charlie bought those chocolates <u>for me</u>.

WITH INDIRECT OBJECT Pronoun

Joe <u>les</u> enseña. Joe teaches <u>them</u>.

Charlie <u>me</u> compró esos chocolates. Charlie bought <u>me</u> those chocolates.

ORDER OF <u>INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS</u> IN SPANISH

BEFORE THE VERB

- Conjugated verbs.
- Perfect tenses.
- Negative commands.

Ya <u>le</u> regalé esa bolsa. I gave <u>her</u> that bag.

> ¡No <u>me</u> cuentes! Don't tell <u>me!</u>



ATTACHED TO THE VERB

- Affirmative commands.
- Infinitive verbs.
- Gerunds.

¡Dá<u>nos</u>lo! Es nuestro. Give it <u>to us!</u> It's ours.

Voy a contar<u>le</u> a Paco. I'm going to tell Paco.

Note: Indirect object pronouns are <u>always</u> placed before direct object pronouns.

VERBS THAT TAKE <u>INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS</u>



DIRECT VS <u>INDIRECT OBJECT</u> PRONOUNS

DIRECT OBJECT

INDIRECT OBJECT



John <u>los</u> pagó (los boletos). John pay <u>them</u> (the tickets).



John <u>le</u> pagó a la cajera. John payed <u>the cashier</u>.

REFLEXIVE VS <u>INDIRECT OBJECT</u> PRONOUNS

LE

Subject performs the action on someone.



<u>Le</u> lavé las manos al bebé. I washed the <u>baby's</u> hands.

Subject performs the action upon itself.



Sandy <u>se</u> lavó las manos. Sandy <u>washed</u> her hands.

KEY POINTS: <u>**INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS</u> IN SPANISH**</u>

- Spanish indirect object pronouns are <u>me</u>, <u>te</u>, <u>le</u>, <u>nos</u>, <u>os</u>, <u>les</u>.
- The pronoun <u>se replaces le/les</u> in sentences which also contain third-person direct object pronouns.
- An indirect object is the part of the sentence <u>affected</u> or <u>benefited</u> by the subject's action.
- The indirect object <u>responds</u> to the questions 'for whom' or 'to whom' (a quién or para quién) an action is performed.

- Spanish indirect object pronouns must be <u>placed before</u> the conjugated verb in sentences with one verb, <u>negative</u> <u>commands</u>, or when using perfect tenses.
- Indirect object pronouns must be <u>attached</u> <u>to affirmative commands</u>, <u>infinitives</u>, and <u>present participles</u>.
- The indirect object pronouns <u>always come</u> <u>before</u> direct object pronouns.
