#1 - To describe the action of reading

(To read)

Formula

[Leer conjugated] + [complement]

Sam **leería** mejor si practicara. Sam **would read** better if he practiced.

Nunca **había leído** un libro tan aburrido. I **had** never **read** such a boring book before.

¿Cuándo **van a leer** el email que les mandé? When are you guys **going to read** the email I sent you?

Take Note: Leer can be combined with nouns when talking about the things someone reads. You can use <u>adverbs of manner</u> to describe how well or bad someone reads.
