TO TAKE, TO HAVE, TO LEAD, TO WEAR,
TO GET ALONG, TO BE IN/CONTAIN

SYNONYMS: **TRANSPORTAR,**
CARGAR, GUIAR

Type	Irregular	Infinitive	Gerund	Past Participle
-AR	NO	Llevar <i>To take</i>	Llevando <i>Taking</i>	Llevado <i>Taken</i>

DEFINITIONS & EXAMPLES (1/2)

LLEVAR

#1 - Talk about taking someone or something to another place
(*To take*)

Formula

[Llevar conjugated] + [noun] + a + [place]

Lleven estas bolsas a la cocina.
Take these bags to the kitchen.

[Llevar conjugated] + a + [person] + [place]

Julie quiere que lleves a las niñas a la escuela.
Julie wants you to take the girls to school.

Take Note: When the context is clear, you can use [Spanish direct object pronouns](#) to replace the thing or person you're talking about.

#2 - Express age gaps and amounts
(*To take / To be older than*)

Formula

[Indirect object pronoun] + [llevar conjugated] + (number) + [infinitive]

Nos llevó dos horas terminar este proyecto.
It took us two hours to finish this project.

¿Cuánto les habrá llevado hacer esta película?
How long might it take them to do this movie?

When referring to amounts, llevar can also be used to express the age gap between a person:

[Indirect object pronoun] + [llevar conjugated] + (number)

Mi hermano me lleva un año.
My brother is one year older than me.

#3 - Talk about the duration of an action
(*To have*)

Formula

[Llevar conjugated] + [present participle]

¿Cuánto llevas esperando?
How long have you been waiting?

Sofía lleva dos años estudiando español.
Sofia has been studying Spanish for two years.

#4 - Ask and talk about the ingredients in a dish
(*To contain / To be in*)

Formula

[Llevar conjugated] + [noun]

¿Qué lleva la ensalada?
What's in the salad?

No sabía que la sopa llevara nueces.
I didn't know that soup contained nuts.



LLEVAR

#5 - Express consequences

(To lead / to cause)

Formula

[Llevar conjugated] + a + (consequence)

Esto nos **llevó** a tomar otras medidas.
This **led** us to take other measures.

Si no hacemos algo, su error nos **llevará** a la ruina.
If we don't do something, his mistake **will lead** us to ruin.

#6 - Describe clothing and accessories someone is wearing

(To wear)

Formula

[Llevar conjugated] + [article] + [noun]

Lucy siempre **lleva** los mismos aretes.
Lucy always **wears** the same earrings.

Creo que Sandra **llevaba** una camisa roja.
I think Sandra **was wearing** a red shirt.

#7 - Talk about how well or bad people get along with others

(To get along)

Formula

[Reflexive pronoun] + [llevar conjugated] + (bien/mal)

Sally y yo **nos llevamos** mal.
Sally and I don't **get along** well.

Ojalá **te lleves** bien con mis papás.
I hope you **get along** with my parents.

Take Note: In this context, [adverbs of manner](#) can help you describe how well or how badly you get along with others.

Yo	Llevo I take	Llevé I took	Llevaba I took / used to take	Llevaré I will take	Llevaría I would take
Tú	Llevas You take	Llevaste You took	Llevabas You took / used to take	Llevarás You will take	Llevarías You would take
Él / Ella Usted	Lleva He/She takes	Llevó He/She took	Llevaba He/She took / used to take	Llevará He/She will take	Llevaría He/She would take
Nosotros	Llevamos We take	Llevamos We took	Llevábamos We took / used to take	Llevaremos We will take	Llevaríamos We would take
Vosotros	Lleváis You take	Llevasteis You took	Llevabais You took / used to take	Llevaréis You will take	Llevaríais You would take
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Llevan They/You take	Llevaron They/You took	Llevaban They/You took / used to take	Llevarán They/You will take	Llevarían They/You would take

PERFECT (COMPOUND) INDICATIVE TENSES

LLEVAR

Pronoun	Present	Past	Future	Conditional
Yo	He llevado I have taken	Había llevado I had taken	Habré llevado I will have taken	Habría llevado I would have taken
Tú	Has llevado You have taken	Habías llevado You had taken	Habrás llevado You will have taken	Habrías llevado You would have taken
Él / Ella Usted	Ha llevado He/She has taken	Había llevado He/She had taken	Habrá llevado He/She will have taken	Habría llevado He/She would have taken
Nosotros	Hemos llevado We have taken	Habíamos llevado We had taken	Habremos llevado We will have taken	Habríamos llevado We would have taken
Vosotros	Habéis llevado You have taken	Habíais llevado You had taken	Habréis llevado You will have taken	Habríais llevado You would have taken
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Han llevado They/You have taken	Habían llevado They/You had taken	Habrán llevado They/You will have taken	Habrían llevado They/You would have taken

PROGRESSIVE (INDICATIVE) TENSES

LLEVAR

Pronoun	Present	Preterite	Imperfect	Future	Conditional
Yo	Estoy llevando I am taking	Estuve llevando I was taking	Estaba llevando I was taking	Estaría llevando I will be taking	Estaré llevando I would be taking
Tú	Estás llevando You are taking	Estuviste llevando You were taking	Estabas llevando You were taking	Estarías llevando You will be taking	Estarás llevando You would be taking
Él / Ella Usted	Está llevando He/She is taking	Estuvo llevando He/She was taking	Estaba llevando He/She was taking	Estaría llevando He/She will be taking	Estará llevando He/She would be taking
Nosotros	Estamos llevando We are taking	Estuvimos llevando We were taking	Estábamos llevando We were taking	Estaríamos llevando We will be taking	Estaremos llevando We would be taking
Vosotros	Estáis llevando You are taking	Estuvisteis llevando You were taking	Estabais llevando You were taking	Estaríais llevando You will be taking	Estaréis llevando You would be taking
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Están llevando They/You are taking	Estuvieron llevando They/You were taking	Estaban llevando They/You were taking	Estarían llevando They/You will be taking	Estarán llevando They/You would be taking

Yo	Lleve I take	Haya llevado I have taken	Llevase I took	Llevara I took	Hubiera llevado I have taken
Tú	Lleves You take	Hayas llevado You have taken	Llevases You took	Llevaras You took	Hubieras llevado You have taken
Él / Ella Usted	Lleve He/She takes	Haya llevado He/She has taken	Llevase He/She took	Llevara He/She took	Hubiera llevado He/She has taken
Nosotros	Llevemos We take	Hayamos llevado We have taken	Llevásemos We took	Lleváramos We took	Hubiéramos llevado We have taken
Vosotros	Llevéis You take	Hayáis llevado You have taken	Llevaseis You took	N/A	Hubierais llevado You have taken
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Lleven They/You take	Hayan llevado They/You have taken	Llevasen They/You took	Llevaran They/You took	Hubieran llevado They/You have taken

IMPERATIVE MOOD TENSES

LLEVAR

Pronoun	Affirmative Commands	Negative Commands
Tú	Lleva Take	No lleves Don't take
Usted	Lleve Take	No lleve Don't take
Vosotros	Llevad Take	No llevéis Don't take
Ustedes	Lleven Take	No lleven Don't take
