### TO PASS, TO HAPPEN/OCCUR, TO CROSS, TO GO BY, TO COME IN

SYNONYMS: OCURRIR, <u>LLEVAR</u>, APROBAR, EXCEDERSE

## **DEFINITIONS & EXAMPLES**

### **PASAR**

#### Depending on the context or sentence, 'pasar' can mean:

To happen/occur, To pass, To give, To go ahead/come in, To go by, To pick (someone) up, To approve (exams or tests)

#### **Formula**

[Pasar conjugated] + [complement]

**Pasa**, por favor. Please, **go ahead**.

No **me han** pasado el pan. You guys **have**n't **passed** me the bread.

Yo **paso** por Diana todos los días. I **pick** Diana **up** every day.

¿Qué **está pasando** con ustedes? What **is happening** with you two?

**Take Note:** When talking about passing something to another person, pasar can work with direct and <u>indirect object pronouns</u>. <u>Spanish direct object pronouns</u> replace the things you're passing and indirect pronouns the person to which you're giving that object.
