TO FEEL, TO (BE) SORRY

SYNONYMS: PERCIBIR, RESENTIRSE, LAMENTAR

	Indicative	Subjunctive	Imperative
Stem Changes	Present: <i>sient</i> for all subject pronouns except 'nosotros' and 'vosotros'. Preterite: <i>sint</i> for 'usted', 'él', 'ella', and their plural forms.	Present: <i>sient</i> for 'yo', 'tú', and the third person singular and plural; <i>sint</i> for 'nosotros' and 'vosotros'. Imperfect: <i>sintie</i> for all subject pronouns.	Affirmative: <i>sient</i> for all subjects except 'vosotros'. Negative: <i>sient</i> for 'tú', 'usted', 'ustedes'; <i>sint</i> for 'vosotros'.

DEFINITIONS & EXAMPLES

SENTIR

#1 - Express condolences, sorrow or regrets

(To be/feel sorry)

Formula

[Sentir conjugated] + (adv) + [complement]

Siento mucho lo que te dije.
I **am** very **sorry** for what I said.

Sentimos mucho lo que te pasó.
We **feel sorry** about what happened to you.

#2 - Describe how people or things feel

(To feel)

Formula

(Reflexive pronoun) + [sentir conjugated] + [complement]

¿Se **sienten** mal?
Do you guys **feel** bad?

Claudia dijo que **sentía** un poco de dolor.
Claudia said that she **felt** a little bit of pain.

Take Note: Use Spanish reflexive pronouns to describe how a person is feeling. If you're talking about how something you're touching feels, you can use [direct object pronouns](#) to replace that thing.

Él / Ella Usted	Ha sentido He/She has felt	Había sentido He/She had felt	Habrá sentido He/She will have felt	Habría sentido He/She would have felt
Nosotros	Hemos sentido We have felt	Habíamos sentido We had felt	Habremos sentido We will have felt	Habríamos sentido We would have felt
Vosotros	Habéis sentido You have felt	Habíais sentido You had felt	Habréis sentido You will have felt	Habríais sentido You would have felt
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Han sentido They/You have felt	Habían sentido They/You had felt	Habrán sentido They/You will have felt	Habrían sentido They/You would have felt

Él / Ella Usted	Está sintiendo He/She is feeling	Estuvo sintiendo He/She was feeling	Estaba sintiendo He/She was feeling	Estaría sintiendo He/She will be feeling	Estará sintiendo He/She would be feeling
Nosotros	Estamos sintiendo We are feeling	Estuvimos sintiendo We were feeling	Estábamos sintiendo We were feeling	Estaríamos sintiendo We will be feeling	Estaremos sintiendo We would be feeling

Tú	Siente Feel	No sientas Don't feel
Usted	Sienta Feel	No sienta Don't feel
Vosotros	Sentid Feel	No sintáis Don't feel
Ustedes	Sientan Feel	No sientan Don't feel
