#### TO FEEL, TO (BE) SORRY

#### **SYNONYMS: PERCIBIR, RESENTIRSE, LAMENTAR**

	Indicative	Subjunctive	Imperative
Stem Changes	Present: sient for all subject pronouns except 'nosotros' and 'vosotros'.  Preterite: sint for 'usted', 'él', 'ella', and their plural forms.	<b>Present:</b> <i>sient</i> for 'yo', 'tú', and the third person singular and plural; sint for 'nosotros' and 'vosotros'. <b>Imperfect:</b> <i>sintie</i> for all subject pronouns.	Affirmative: sient for all subjects except 'vosotros'.  Negative: sient for 'tú', 'usted', 'ustedes'; sint for 'vosotros'.

#### **SENTIR**

#### #1 - Express condolences, sorrow or regrets

(To be/feel sorry)

**Formula** 

[Sentir conjugated] + (adv) + [complement]

**Siento** mucho lo que te dije. l am very sorry for what I said.

**Sentimos** mucho lo que te pasó. We **feel sorry** about what happened to you. #2 - Describe how people or things feel

(To feel)

**Formula** 

(Reflexive pronoun) + [sentir conjugated] + [complement]

¿Se **sienten** mal? Do you guys **feel** bad?

Claudia dijo que **sentía** un poco de dolor. Claudia said that she **felt** a little bit of pain.

**Take Note:** Use Spanish reflexive pronouns to describe how a person is feeling. If you're talking about how something you're touching feels, you can use <u>direct object pronouns</u> to replace that thing.
