SYNONYMS: **ANDAR, PASEAR, IR**

Type	Irregular	Infinitive	Gerund	Past Participle
-AR	NO	Caminar <i>To walk</i>	Caminando <i>Walking</i>	Caminado <i>Walked</i>

DEFINITION & EXAMPLES

CAMINAR

To talk about walking
(To walk)

Formula

[Caminar conjugated] + [complement]

Gabriel **camina** muy rápido.
Gabriel **walks** very fast.

Cindy y yo **vamos a caminar** al parque.
Cindy and I **are going to walk** to the park.

Ayer **caminé** hasta la farmacia.
Yesterday, I **walked** all the way to the pharmacy.

Take Note: Although it's the direct translation of 'to walk', in Spanish, we don't say *caminar a los perros* (walk the dogs). For this case, you can say 'pasear a los perros' or 'sacar a los perros a caminar'. Make sure you conjugate the verbs.

Él / Ella Usted	Camina He/She walks	Caminó He/She walked	Caminaba He/She walked / used to walk	Caminará He/She will walk	Caminaría He/She would walk
Nosotros	Caminamos We walk	Caminamos We walked	Caminábamos We walked / used to walk	Caminaremos We will walk	Caminaríamos We would walk
Vosotros	Camináis You walk	Caminasteis You walked	Caminabais You walked / used to walk	Caminaréis You will walk	Caminaríais You would walk
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Caminan They/You walk	Caminaron They/You walked	Caminaban They/You walked / used to walk	Caminarán They/You will walk	Caminarían They/You would walk

PERFECT (COMPOUND) INDICATIVE TENSES

Pronoun	Present	Past	Future	Conditional
Yo	He caminado I have walked	Había caminado I had walked	Habré caminado I will have walked	Habría caminado I would have walked
Tú	Has caminado You have walked	Habías caminado You had walked	Habrás caminado You will have walked	Habrías caminado You would have walked
Él / Ella Usted	Ha caminado He/She has walked	Había caminado He/She had walked	Habrá caminado He/She will have walked	Habría caminado He/She would have walked
Nosotros	Hemos caminado We have walked	Habíamos caminado We had walked	Habremos caminado We will have walked	Habríamos caminado We would have walked
Vosotros	Habéis caminado You have walked	Habíais caminado You had walked	Habréis caminado You will have walked	Habríais caminado You would have walked
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Han caminado They/You have walked	Habían caminado They/You had walked	Habrán caminado They/You will have walked	Habrían caminado They/You would have walked

Yo	Estoy caminando I am walking	Estuve caminando I was walking	Estaba caminando I was walking	Estaría caminando I will be walking	Estaré caminando I would be walking
Tú	Estás caminando You are walking	Estuviste caminando You were walking	Estabas caminando You were walking	Estarías caminando You will be walking	Estarás caminando You would be walking
Él / Ella Usted	Está caminando He/She is walking	Estuvo caminando He/She was walking	Estaba caminando He/She was walking	Estaría caminando He/She will be walking	Estará caminando He/She would be walking
Nosotros	Estamos caminando We are walking	Estuvimos caminando We were walking	Estábamos caminando We were walking	Estaríamos caminando We will be walking	Estaremos caminando We would be walking
Vosotros	Estáis caminando You are walking	Estuvisteis caminando You were walking	Estabais caminando You were walking	Estaríais caminando You will be walking	Estaréis caminando You would be walking
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Están caminando They/You are walking	Estuvieron caminando They/You were walking	Estaban caminando They/You were walking	Estarían caminando They/You will be walking	Estarán caminando They/You would be walking

Nosotros	Caminemos We walk	Hayamos caminado We have walked	Caminásemos We walked	Camináramos We walked	Hubiéramos caminado We have walked
Vosotros	Caminéis You walk	Hayáis caminado You have walked	Caminaseis You walked	N/A	Hubierais caminado You have walked
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Caminen They/You walk	Hayan caminado They/You have walked	Caminasen They/You walked	Caminaran They/You walked	Hubieran caminado They/You have walked

CAMINAR

Pronoun	Affirmative Commands	Negative Commands
Tú	Camina Walk	No camines Don't walk
Usted	Camine Walk	No camine Don't walk
Vosotros	Camina Walk	No caminéis Don't walk
Ustedes	Caminen Walk	No caminen Don't walk
