TO HAVE, TO BE

SYNONYMS: **EXISTIR**, **TENER**

Type	Irregular	Infinitive	Gerund	Past Participle

Irregularities	Present: <i>h</i> for all subject pronouns. Preterite: <i>hub</i> for all subject pronouns. Future & Conditional: <i>habr</i> for all subject pronouns.	Present: <i>hay</i> for all subject pronouns. Imperfect: <i>hubie</i> for all subject pronouns.

DEFINITIONS & EXAMPLES

HABER

#1 - As an auxiliary verb in the perfect tenses

(*To have*)

Formula

[Haber conjugated] + [past participle]

Ya **he ido** a ese lugar varias veces
I **have** already **gone** to that place many times.

Cuando llegamos, el camión ya se **había ido**.
When we arrived, the bus **had** already **left**.

#2 - To express existence

(*To be*)

Formula

[Third person singular of haber] + [determiner] + [noun]

¿Por qué **hay** tanta gente en la calle?
Why **are there** so many people on the street?

En unos días, **habrá** más información.
There will be more information in a few days.

IMPERATIVE MOOD TENSES

HABER

In Spanish, we use the imperative mood to command people on what to do or not to do. Because the perfect tenses refer to actions that were already completed or will take place someday, in its auxiliary form, haber cannot be conjugated to the imperative tense.

Additionally, none of the haber impersonal forms (hay, hube, había, etc) can be conjugated to the imperative tenses. This is because you cannot command something to exist.
