TO CALL, TO BE NAMED

SYNONYMS: **MARCAR**, **HABLAR**, **GUSTAR**

Type	Irregular	Infinitive	Gerund	Past Participle
-AR	NO	Llamar <i>To call</i>	Llamando <i>Calling</i>	Llamado <i>Called</i>

DEFINITION & EXAMPLES

LLAMAR

Llamar can mean to:

'Call', 'To be named', 'To knock', or 'To appeal/attract/be interested in'

Formula

[Pronoun in Spanish] + [llamar conjugated]

¿Cómo te **llamas**?

What **is** your **name**?

¿Por qué no me **has llamado**?

Why **haven't** you **called** me?

A Lucy no le **llaman** la atención esas películas.

Lucy **is** not **interested** in those movies.

Take Note: When using [direct object pronouns](#), llamar means to call someone (including over the phone). On the other hand, you can combine this verb with reflexive pronouns when [saying someone's name in Spanish](#). And finally, if you're expressing that someone is interested in something, you must use [indirect object pronouns](#).

LLAMAR

Pronoun	Present	Preterite	Imperfect	Future	Conditional
Yo	Llamo I call	Llamé I called	Llamaba I called / used to call	Llamaré I will call	Llamaría I would call
Tú	Llamas You call	Llamaste You called	Llamabas You called / used to call	Llamarás You will call	Llamarías You would call
Él / Ella Usted	Llama He/She calls	Llamó He/She called	Llamaba He/She called / used to call	Llamará He/She will call	Llamaría He/She would call
Nosotros	Llamamos We call	Llamamos We called	Llamábamos We called / used to call	Llamaremos We will call	Llamaríamos We would call
Vosotros	Llamáis You call	Llamasteis You called	Llamabais You called / used to call	Llamaréis You will call	Llamaríais You would call
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Lllaman They/You call	Lllamaron They/You called	Lllamaban They/You called / used to call	Lllamarán They/You will call	Lllamarían They/You would call

PERFECT (COMPOUND) INDICATIVE TENSES

LLAMAR

Pronoun	Present	Past	Future	Conditional
Yo	He llamado I have called	Había llamado I had called	Habré llamado I will have called	Habría llamado I would have called
Tú	Has llamado You have called	Habías llamado You had called	Habrás llamado You will have called	Habrías llamado You would have called
Él / Ella Usted	Ha llamado He/She has called	Había llamado He/She had called	Habrá llamado He/She will have called	Habría llamado He/She would have called
Nosotros	Hemos llamado We have called	Habíamos llamado We had called	Habremos llamado We will have called	Habríamos llamado We would have called
Vosotros	Habéis llamado You have called	Habíais llamado You had called	Habréis llamado You will have called	Habríais llamado You would have called
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Han llamado They/You have called	Habían llamado They/You had called	Habrán llamado They/You will have called	Habrían llamado They/You would have called

PROGRESSIVE (INDICATIVE) TENSES

LLAMAR

Pronoun	Present	Preterite	Imperfect	Future	Conditional
Yo	Estoy llamando I am calling	Estuve llamando I was calling	Estaba llamando I was calling	Estaría llamando I will be calling	Estaré llamando I would be calling
Tú	Estás llamando You are calling	Estuviste llamando You were calling	Estabas llamando You were calling	Estarías llamando You will be calling	Estarás llamando You would be calling
Él / Ella Usted	Está llamando He/She is calling	Estuvo llamando He/She was calling	Estaba llamando He/She was calling	Estaría llamando He/She will be calling	Estará llamando He/She would be calling
Nosotros	Estamos llamando We are calling	Estuvimos llamando We were calling	Estábamos llamando We were calling	Estaríamos llamando We will be calling	Estaremos llamando We would be calling
Vosotros	Estáis llamando You are calling	Estuvisteis llamando You were calling	Estabais llamando You were calling	Estaríais llamando You will be calling	Estaréis llamando You would be calling
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Están llamando They/You are calling	Estuvieron llamando They/You were calling	Estaban llamando They/You were calling	Estarían llamando They/You will be calling	Estarán llamando They/You would be calling

Yo	Llame I call	Haya llamado I have called	Llamase I called	Llamara I called	Hubiera llamado I have called
Tú	Llames You call	Hayas llamado You have called	Llamases You called	Llamaras You called	Hubieras llamado You have called
Él / Ella Usted	Llame He/She calls	Haya llamado He/She has called	Llamase He/She called	Llamara He/She called	Hubiera llamado He/She has called
Nosotros	Llamemos We call	Hayamos llamado We have called	Llamásemos We called	Llamáramos We called	Hubiéramos llamado We have called
Vosotros	Llaméis You call	Hayáis llamado You have called	Llamaseis You called	N/A	Hubierais llamado You have called
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Llamen They/You call	Hayan llamado They/You have called	Llamasen They/You called	Llamaran They/You called	Hubieran llamado They/You have called

IMPERATIVE MOOD TENSES

LLAMAR

Pronoun	Affirmative Commands	Negative Commands
Tú	Llama Call	No llames Don't call
Usted	Llame Call	No llame Don't call
Vosotros	Llamad Call	No llaméis Don't call
Ustedes	Llamen Call	No llamen Don't call
