#### SYNONYMS: MARCAR, HABLAR, GUSTAR

#### **DEFINITION & EXAMPLES**

LLAMAR

#### Llamar can mean to:

'Call', 'To be named', 'To knock', or 'To appeal/attract/be interested in'

#### **Formula**

[Pronoun in Spanish] + [Ilamar conjugated]

¿Cómo te **llamas**? What **is** your **name**?

¿Por qué no me has llamado? Why haven't you called me?

A Lucy no le **llaman** la atención esas películas. Lucy **is** not **interested** in those movies.

**Take Note:** When using <u>direct object pronouns</u>, llamar means to call someone (including over the phone). On the other hand, you can combine this verb with reflexive pronouns when <u>saying someone's name in Spanish</u>. And finally, if you're expressing that someone is interested in something, you must use <u>indirect object pronouns</u>.
