TO COME

SYNONYMS: VOLVER, REGRESAR, ORIGINARSE

Type	Irregular	Infinitive	Gerund	Past Participle
-IR	YES	Venir <i>To come</i>	Viniendo <i>Coming</i>	Venido <i>Come</i>

	Indicative	Subjunctive	Imperative
Irregularities	Present: <i>veng</i> only for 'yo' Future & Conditional: <i>vendr</i> for all subject pronouns.	Present: <i>veng</i> for all subject pronouns.	Affirmative: <i>ven</i> only for 'tú', <i>veng</i> for 'usted' and 'ustedes'. Negative: <i>veng</i> for all subject pronouns.

	Indicative	Subjunctive
Stem Changes	Present: <i>vien</i> for all subject pronouns except 'nosotros' and 'vosotros'. Preterite: <i>vin</i> for all subject pronouns and omit accent marks.	Imperfect: <i>vinie</i> for all subject pronouns.

DEFINITIONS & EXAMPLES

VENIR

#1 - Expressing that someone is coming to a place
(*To come*)

Formula

[Venir conjugated] + [complement]

Tu tía **va a venir** a la casa.
Your aunt **is coming** to the house.

La bebé **viene** dormida.
The baby **is** asleep.

El plomero **vendrá** a arreglar el lavabo.
The plumber **will come** to fix the sink.

Take Note: Venir expresses that someone is coming to the speaker's location. Combine this verb with an [infinitive verb](#) to express that someone is coming over to do something (example #3). Use [past participles working as adjectives](#) to describe how someone is coming to a place.

#2 - To talk about obligations
(*To come/arrive / To appear*)

Formula

[Venir conjugated] + (en) + (noun)

La noticia **viene** en la página 40.
The news **is** on page 40.

La palabra 'almohada' **viene** del árabe.
The word 'almohada' **comes** from Arabic.

Take Note: Venir can be combined with [present participles](#) to express an ongoing action. However, in this context, it's more common to use [the verb estar](#) or [llevar](#).

Nosotros	Venimos We come	Vinimos We came	Veníamos We came / used to come	Vendremos We will come	Vendríamos We would come
Vosotros	Venís You come	Vinisteis You came	Veníais You came / used to come	Vendréis You will come	Vendríais You would come
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Vienen They/You come	Vinieron They/You came	Venían They/You came / used to come	Vendrán They/You will come	Vendrían They/You would come

PERFECT (COMPOUND) INDICATIVE TENSES

VENIR

Pronoun	Present	Past	Future	Conditional
Yo	He venido I have come	Había venido I had come	Habré venido I will have come	Habría venido I would have come
Tú	Has venido You have come	Habías venido You had come	Habrás venido You will have come	Habrías venido You would have come
Él / Ella Usted	Ha venido He/She has come	Había venido He/She had come	Habrá venido He/She will have come	Habría venido He/She would have come
Nosotros	Hemos venido We have come	Habíamos venido We had come	Habremos venido We will have come	Habríamos venido We would have come
Vosotros	Habéis venido You have come	Habíais venido You had come	Habréis venido You will have come	Habríais venido You would have come
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Han venido They/You have come	Habían venido They/You had come	Habrán venido They/You will have come	Habrían venido They/You would have come

Yo	Estoy viniendo I am coming	Estuve viniendo I was coming	Estaba viniendo I was coming	Estaría viniendo I will be coming	Estaré viniendo I would be coming
Tú	Estás viniendo You are coming	Estuviste viniendo You were coming	Estabas viniendo You were coming	Estarías viniendo You will be coming	Estarás viniendo You would be coming
Él / Ella Usted	Está viniendo He/She is coming	Estuvo viniendo He/She was coming	Estaba viniendo He/She was coming	Estaría viniendo He/She will be coming	Estará viniendo He/She would be coming
Nosotros	Estamos viniendo We are coming	Estuvimos viniendo We were coming	Estábamos viniendo We were coming	Estaríamos viniendo We will be coming	Estaremos viniendo We would be coming
Vosotros	Estáis viniendo You are coming	Estuvisteis viniendo You were coming	Estabais viniendo You were coming	Estaríais viniendo You will be coming	Estaréis viniendo You would be coming

Vosotros	Vengáis You come	Hayáis venido You have come	Vinieseis You came	N/A	Hubierais venido You have come
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	Vengan They/You come	Hayan venido They/You have come	Viniesen They/You came	Vinieran They/You came	Hubieran venido They/You have come

VENIR

Pronoun	Affirmative Commands	Negative Commands
Tú	Ven Come	No vengas Don't come
Usted	Venga Come	No venga Don't come
Vosotros	Venid Come	No vengáis Don't come
Ustedes	Vengan Come	No vengan Don't come
