DEFINITIONS & EXAMPLES

VENIR

#1 - Expressing that someone is coming to a place

(To come)

Formula

[Venir conjugated] + [complement]

Tu tía **va a venir** a la casa. Your aunt **is coming** to the house.

> La bebé **viene** dormida. The baby **is** asleep.

El plomero **vendrá** a arreglar el lavabo. The plumber **will come** to fix the sink.

Take Note: Venir expresses that someone is coming to the speaker's location. Combine this verb with an <u>infinitive verb</u> to express that someone is coming over to do something (example #3). Use <u>past participles working as adjectives</u> to describe how someone is coming to a place.

#2 - To talk about obligations

(To come/arrive / To appear)

Formula

[Venir conjugated] + (en) + (noun)

La noticia **viene** en la página 40. The news **is** on page 40.

La palabra 'almohada' **viene** del árabe. The word 'almohada' **comes** from Arabic.

Take Note: Venir can be combined with <u>present participles</u> to express an ongoing action. However, in this context, it's more common to use <u>the verb estar</u> or <u>llevar</u>.
