RECIPROCAL VERBS IN SPANISH

KEY POINTS

- Reciprocal verbs have <u>two</u> or <u>more</u> subjects.
- These subjects do and also receive the action (direct objects).



Nosotros <u>nos</u> caemos mal. We don't like each other.

¿Por qué Adrián y Vanessa se miran tanto? Why do Adrian and Vanessa look at <u>each other</u> so much?



REFLEXIVE VS RECIPROCAL VERBS IN SPANISH

RECIPROCAL VERBS

The action is done to <u>each other</u>. Only <u>plural form</u>.



Ellos <u>se</u> abrazan. They hold <u>each other</u>.

REFLEXIVE VERBS

The action is done on oneself.



Yo <u>me</u> abrazo. I hugged <u>myself</u>.

RECIPROCAL VS REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

Reflexive verbs can also use singular pronouns since an individual person can perform an action on him- or herself whereas reciprocal actions can only be performed on 2 or more people (each other).

Subject	Reflexive Pronoun	Reciprocal Pronoun
Yo	Me	-
Tú	Те	-
Él / Ella / Usted	Se	-
Nosotros	Nos	Nos
Vosotros	Os	Os
Ellos / Ellas / Ustedes	Se	Se

CONJUGATING RECIPROCAL VERBS IN SPANISH

Follow the same steps you'll use to <u>conjugate reflexive verbs in Spanish</u>. Remove the <u>infinitive ending</u> and add the tense endings you need.

-AR VERBS

-ER VERBS

-IR VERBS

	Salud <u>ar</u> se	Quer <u>er</u> se	Desped <u>ir</u> se
Nosotros / Nosotras	Nosotros nos saludamos	Nosotros nos queremos	Nosotros nos despedimos
Vosotros / Vosotras	Vosotros os saludáis	Vosotros os queréis	Vosotros os despedís
Ellos / Ellas / Ustedes	Ellos se saludan	Ellos se quieren	Ellos se despiden

KEY POINTS: <u>RECIPROCAL VERBS</u> IN SPANISH

Reciprocal verbs:

- Describe actions that two or more people perform on each other.
- In order to express reciprocity, they are always conjugated in the plural form.
- Only work with the <u>pronouns</u> 'se', 'nos', 'os'. They can be translated as <u>'each other'</u>.

Reflexive verbs:

- Describe actions that a person performs on herself/himself.
- Works with both singular and plural forms.
