PREPOSITIONAL <u>Pronouns</u> in Spanish

PREPOSITIONAL PRONOUNS

They are <u>preceded</u> by a preposition

Prepositional Pronoun	Person
Mí	Yo
Ті	Tú
Él / Ella / Usted	Él/Ella/Usted
Nosotros/as	Nosotros
Vosotros/as	Vosotros
Ellos / Ellas / Ustedes	Ellos / Ustedes



¿Esas flores son para mí? Are those flowers for me?

Note: Watch out for the exceptions with 'con', 'entre', 'excepto', 'menos'.
