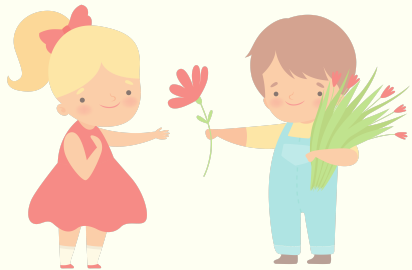

# PREPOSITIONAL PRONOUNS IN SPANISH

## PREPOSITIONAL PRONOUNS

They are preceded by a preposition

Person	Prepositional Pronoun
Yo	Mí
Tú	Ti
Él / Ella / Usted	Él / Ella / Usted
Nosotros	Nosotros/as
Vosotros	Vosotros/as
Ellos / Ustedes	Ellos / Ellas / Ustedes



¿Esas flores son **para mí**?  
Are those flowers **for me**?

**Note:** Watch out for the exceptions with 'con', 'entre', 'excepto', 'menos'.
