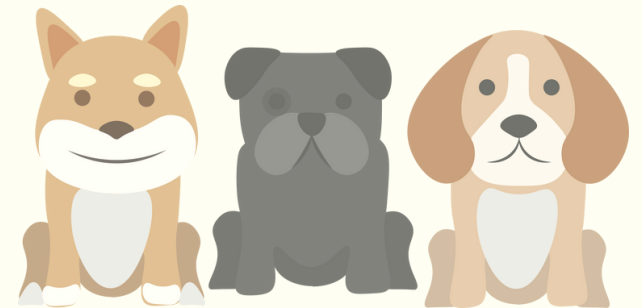
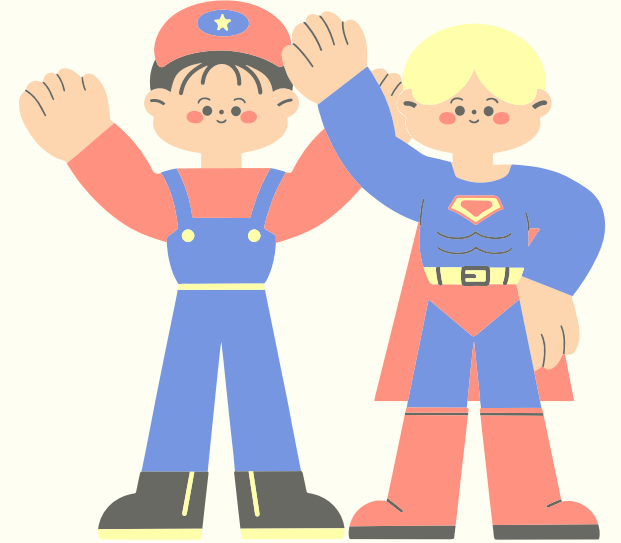

# FORMING THE CONDITIONAL IN SPANISH

## INFINITIVE VERB

Hablar

Comer

Dormir

+

## CONDITIONAL ENDINGS

-ía

-íamos

-ías

-íais

-ía

-ían

**Note:** In the conditional and future tenses, you use the verb's infinitive form instead of the root.

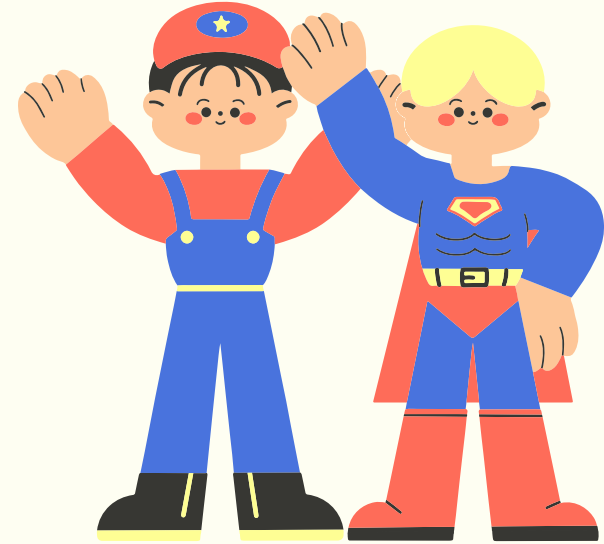
Caber	Querer	Cabr-	Querr-		-ía
Decir	Saber	Dir-	Sabr-		-ías
Haber	Salir	Habr-	Saldr-	+	-ía
Hacer	Tener	Har-	Tendr-		-íamos
Poder	Valer	Podr-	Valdr-		-íais
Poner	Venir	Pondr-	Vendr-		-ían

**Note:** The conditional and future simple tenses have the same irregular verbs.

# CONDITIONS & HYPOTHETICAL SITUATIONS

## KEY POINTS

- Hypothetical situations that unlikely to happen and depend on a condition.
- Their condition is not currently true and it's difficult to achieve.
- It includes wishes and hopes.



Si fuera un superhéroe, sería Batman.  
If I was a superhero, I would be Batman.

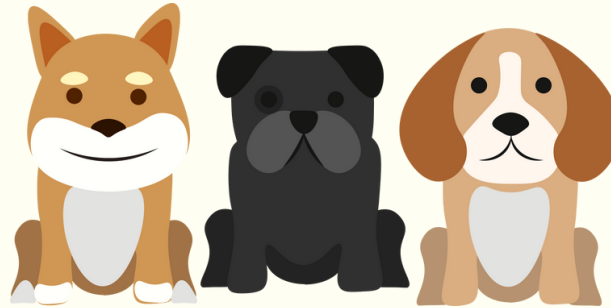
# USES OF THE CONDITIONAL IN SPANISH

## EXPRESS POLITENESS



¿Podría traerme la cuenta?  
Could you bring me the bill?

## HYPOTHETICAL SITUATIONS



Me gustaría tener tres perros.  
I would like to have three dogs.

## CONJECTURES ABOUT THE PAST



Juan ya debería estar aquí.  
Juan should be here by now.

# KEY POINTS: SPANISH CONDITIONAL TENSE

- The same conjugation endings are used for all regular and irregular verbs.
  - These endings are -ía, -ías, -ía, -íamos, -íais, -ían.
- Regular conditional verbs are conjugated by adding the conditional ending to the verb's root.
- Irregular conditional verbs have a stem different from their infinitive form.
- This tense expresses conditions, politeness, hypothetical situations, and conjectures.
- It's also used to form indirect speech in Spanish.
