# FORMING THE FUTURE PERFECT IN SPANISH

EXAMPLE: ESTAR, TENER & DORMIR IN FUTURE PERFECT

Person	Future forms of haber	+	Past participle
Yo	Habré		estado
Tú	Habrás		
Él / Ella	Habrá		
Nosotros	Haremos	+ 	tenido
Vosotros	Habréis		
Ellos / Ustedes	Habrán		dormido

Habré terminado el libro antes de las dos.  
I will have finished the book before two.

# CONDITIONAL VS FUTURE PERFECT IN SPANISH

## FUTURE PERFECT

Actions will be done before a future time or event.



Habremos llegado antes de las dos.

We will have arrived before two.

## CONDITIONAL PERFECT

Things would have happened if a condition had been met.



Si no hubiera llovido, habría ido.

If it hadn't rained, I would have gone.
