FORMING THE FUTURE PERFECT IN SPANISH

EXAMPLE: ESTAR, TENER & DORMIR IN FUTURE PERFECT

Person	Future forms of haber	+	Past participle
Yo	Habré	+	estado
Tú	Habrás		tenido
Él / Ella	Habrá		dormido
Nosotros	Habremos		
Vosotros	Habréis		
Ellos / Ustedes	Habrán		

HOW THE SPANISH FUTURE PERFECT WORKS

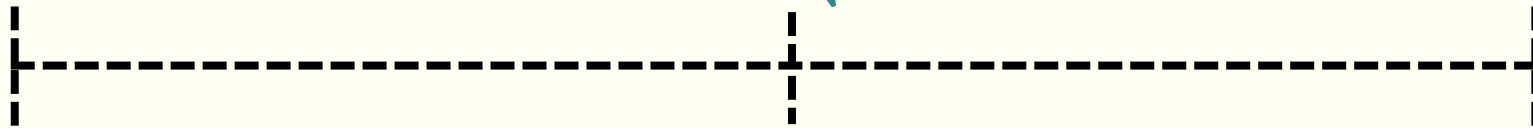
Present

Habré terminado el libro antes de las dos.

I *will have* finished the book before two.

CONDITIONAL VS FUTURE PERFECT IN SPANISH

FUTURE PERFECT

Actions will be done before a future time or event.



Habremos llegado antes de las dos.
We will have arrived before two.

CONDITIONAL PERFECT

Things would have happened if a condition had been met.



Si no hubiera llovido, **habría ido**.
If it hadn't rained, **I would have gone**.
