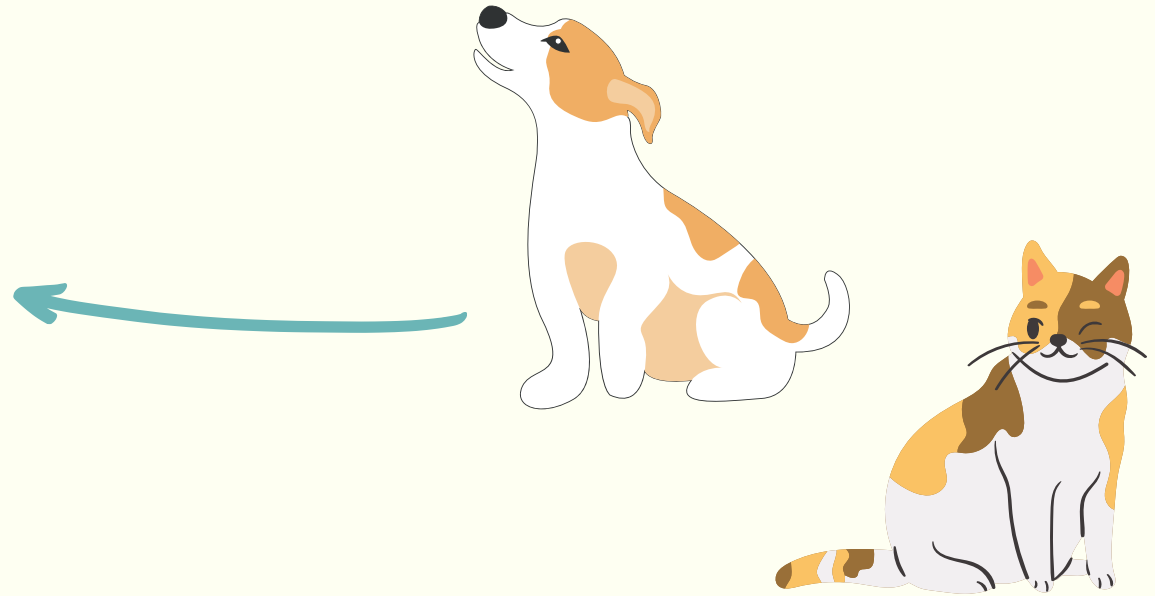

Ella **limpia** las ventanas.
She **cleans** the windows.

INTRANSITIVE

Has meaning on its own.



Ellos **trabajan** todo el día.
They **work** all day.
