IR VERBS	-o	-imos	-í	-imos	-ía	-íamos	Tú <u>vives</u> en Madrid. You <u>live</u> in Madrid.

HOW TO CONJUGATE IR VERBS IN SPANISH

STEP 1

Identify the infinitive ending.

VIVIR

STEP 2

Remove the 'ir' ending.

VIV-

STEP 3

Add the conjugated ending to the root.

Yo vivoo

Tu vivese

Él vivee

Nosotros vivimos

Vosotros Vivís

Ustedes viven

Note: Each Spanish tense has a different conjugation endings.
