# FORMING THE SPANISH IMPERFECT SUBJUNCTIVE

## Conjugation Steps

1. Take the third-person plural preterite form of the verb you want to conjugate.
2. Remove the ending '-ron'.
3. Add the appropriate past subjunctive ending.

Person	Verb Endings
Yo	-ra / -se
TÚ	-ras / -ses
Él / Ella / Usted	-ra / -se
Nosotros	-ramos / -semos
Vostros	-rais / -seis
Ellos / Ellas / Ustedes	- ran / -sen

# STEPS TO FORMING THE PAST SUBJUNCTIVE

## STEP #1

Start with the 3rd person plural preterite form.

- (Ellos) pagaron
- (Ellos) tuvieron
- (Ellos) se vistieron

## STEP #2

Remove the ending -ron.

- paga-
- tuvie-
- vistie-

## STEP #3

Add the past subjunctive ending.

- Yo pagara
- Tú tuvieras
- Nosotros nos vistíramos

**Note:** all the conjugations for the pronoun 'nosotros' in the imperfect subjunctive must include an accent mark on the vowel that precedes the imperfect subjunctive ending.

# IMPERFECT SUBJUNCTIVE IRREGULAR VERBS

## IRREGULAR STEMS

'uv' in the stem

Estar > **Estuvie-**

Tener > **Tuvie-**

Andar > **Anduvie-**

'u' in the stem

saber > **supie-**

poner > **pusie-**

haber > **hubie-**

caber > **cupie-**

poder > **pudie-**

'j' in the stem

traer > **traje-**

traducir > **traduje-**

conducir > **conduje-**

'i' in the stem

decir > **dije-**

hacer > **hicie-**

venir > **vinie-**

querer > **quisie-**



## IRREGULAR ENDINGS

Person	Verb Endings
Yo	-ra / -se
TÚ	-ras / -ses
Él / Ella / Usted	-ra / -se
Nosotros	-ramos / -semos
Vostros	-rais / -seis
Ellos / Ellas / Ustedes	-ran / -sen

# USING THE PAST SUBJUNCTIVE SPANISH TENSE

## EXPRESS POLITENESS



Quisiera pedirle un favor.  
I would like to ask you for a favor.

## PAST HOPES, DOUBTS, ETC.



Les pedí que tuvieran cuidado.  
I asked you to be careful.

## UNLIKELY SITUATIONS



Ojalá fuerá un oso panda.  
I wish I was a panda bear.

# KEY POINTS: SPANISH IMPERFECT SUBJUNCTIVE

- The Spanish imperfect subjunctive conjugations use the stem from the third-person plural form of the preterite tense.
- To form this tense, you must replace the past indicative termination -ron with the corresponding imperfect subjunctive conjugation.
- Irregular verbs in the past preterite are also irregular in this subjunctive tense.
- In Spanish, the imperfect subjunctive tense refers to past doubts, wishes, advice, and suggestions someone had.
- It also expresses conditions and wishes that are unlikely to happen.
