# HOW TO CONJUGATE GUSTAR

FORMULA #1: 1 Thing

Me gusta + el / la + [sing. noun]



Me gusta el chocolate.  
I like chocolate.

FORMULA #2: Activity

Me gusta + [infinitive]



Me gusta leer.  
I like reading.

FORMULA #3: Things

Me gusta + el / la + [pl. noun]



Me gustan los libros de terror.  
I like horror books.

**Note:** Definite articles, possessive and demonstrative adjectives work with gustar.

# HOW DOES GUSTAR WORK



Ellos pasean a su perro.  
They walk their dog.

Subject                                      Object



A mí me gustan los perros.  
I like dogs.

Object                                      Subject

**Note:** Verbs like 'gustar' invert the order of elements: OVS instead of SVS.

# PRONOUNS THAT WORK WITH GUSTAR

## PREPOSITIONAL

(A mí)  
(A ti)  
(A él/a ella/a usted)  
(A nosotros)  
(A vosotros)  
(A ellos/a ellas/a ustedes)

## INDIRECT

Me  
Te  
Le  
Nos  
Os  
Les



\_\_\_ gusta + el / la + [noun]  
\_\_\_ gustan + los / las + [nouns]  
gusta + [infinitive verb]

**Note:** A + pronouns/noun is optional. It clarifies or introduces the object.
