HOW TO CONJUGATE GUSTAR

FORMULA #1: 1 Thing

FORMULA #2: Activity

FORMULA #3: Things

Me gusta + el / la + [sing. noun]



Me gusta el chocolate.
I like chocolate.

Me gusta + [infinitive]



Me gusta leer.
I like reading.

Me gusta + el / la + [pl. noun]



Me gustan los libros de terror.
I like horror books.

Note: Definite articles, possessive and demonstrative adjectives work with gustar.

HOW DOES GUSTAR WORK



Ellos pasean a su perro.
They walk their dog.

Subject

Object



A mí me gustan los perros.
I like dogs.

Note: Verbs like 'gustar' invert the order of elements: OVS instead of SVS.

PRONOUNS THAT WORK WITH GUSTAR

(A mí)

(A ti)

(A él/a ella/a usted)

(A nosotros)

(A vosotros)

(A ellos/a ellas/a ustedes)

INDIRECT

Me

Te

Le

Nos

Os

Les



___ gusta + el / la + [noun]

___ gustan + los / las + [nouns]

gusta + [infinitive verb]

Note: A + pronouns/noun is optional. It clarifies or introduces the object.
