Identify the infinitive ending.

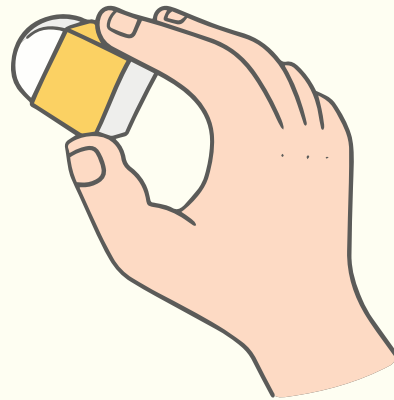
-ar

Pronoun	Present	Preterite	Imperfect	Conditional	Future
Yo	-o	-é	-aba	-ía	-é
Tú	-as	-aste	-abas	-ías	-ás
Él / Ella Usted	-a	-ó	-aba	-ía	-á
Nosotros	-amos	-amos	-ábamos	-íamos	-emos
Vosotros	-áis	-asteis	-abais	-íais	-éis
Ellos / Ellas Ustedes	-an	-aron	-aban	-ían	-án

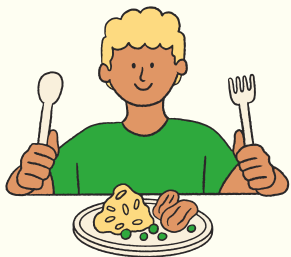
