

# HOW VERBS LIKE 'GUSTAR' WORK

The subject does the action.



Subject + Verb + Object

Sonia y Pedro bailan mucho.  
Sonia and Pedro dance a lot.

The subject provokes a feeling.



Object + Verb + Subject

A Sonia le dan miedo los payasos.  
Sonia is scared of clowns.

## ACTIVITIES



IOP + sing. form + infinitive

Me encanta bailar.  
I like dancing.

## SINGULAR THING



IOP + sing. form + el/la + sing. noun

Me gusta el chocolate caliente.  
I like hot cocoa.

## PLURAL THINGS



IOP + pl form + los/las + pl noun

Me gustan los postres.  
I like desserts.

# PRONOMINAL VERBS VS VERBS LIKE 'GUSTAR'

Pronominal verb



Ayer **me** quedé en casa.  
Yesterday **I** stayed home.

Verb like 'gustar'



Esta **blusa** no **me** queda.  
This **blouse** doesn't fit.

# HOW TO CONJUGATE VERBS LIKE 'GUSTAR'

| Present     | Molesta    | Molestan    | Duele    | Duelen   | Aburre    | Aburren    |
| Preterite   | Molestó    | Molestaron  | Dolió    | Dolieron | Aburrió   | Aburrieron |
| Imperfect   | Molestaba  | Molestaban  | Dolía    | Dolían   | Aburría   | Aburrían   |
| Future      | Molestará  | Molestarán  | Dolerá   | Dolerán  | Aburrirá  | Aburrirán  |
| Conditional | Molestaría | Molestarían | Dolería  | Dolerían | Aburriría | Aburrirían |

# KEY POINTS: VERBS LIKE GUSTAR

- **Verbs like gustar** describe feelings, likes, dislikes, or interests that something (subject) causes in someone (object).
- Instead of subject pronouns, these words use **indirect object pronouns** and are conjugated **based on what** provokes a feeling or reaction.
- In Spanish, verbs like 'gustar' use the conjugating endings of the **third person singular and plural**. In other words, they have a **singular** or **plural** conjugation.
- These structures **do not exist** in English. As a result, they do not always have literal, direct translations.
- Verbs like 'gustar' may have a **pronominal form**. However, these pronominal forms may have different meanings.
